Jessi Slaughter Cyberbullying Controversy refers to a series of abusive messages made against Damien Leonhardt (formerly known as Jessica Leonhardt and internet aliases Jesse Slaughter and KerliGirl13). At the age of 10, Leonhardt was the target of a massive 4chan raid in July 2010 after launching a public tirade against community image boards in a series of YouTube videos. At the time, many believed she was in a sexual relationship with Bud on the dance floor singer Dashi Vanity (real name: Jesus David Torres). The feud quickly led to hundreds of macro images and remixes of videos mocking Jessica and her father, who later became involved in the drama, and sparked one of the first public discussions about cyberbullying as a serious media problem. Between 2013 and 2020, Leonhardt publicly accused Torres of sexual assault, which Torres denied. More than 20 women have charged Torres with assault. Online Story July 10, 2010, StickyDrama user tdomf_e8e13 published an accusation that the vocalist of the electronic group Blood On The Dance Floor (BOTDF) Dahvi Vanity conducts a sexual relationship with a minor Jessica Leonhardt. BOTDF lead singer Dahvi Vanity on it again! He's apparently with a friend with the benefits of a type of relationship with self-accused scene queen Jesse Slaughter, who is only 11! I also spoke to other people who say they fuck last summer when she was 10. On July 12, Leonhardt posted a response to StickyDrama, denying the claims. The STFU people are a very personal matter and they deal with it. This post ruined Muh's life... And yes, it was Muh's status on MySpace! Cuzz I saw squirrel fall out of the tree in the fly backyard! It was Funna For Fur! Muh Mom read this and talks to Dahvie on Fone Right Nao! So I'd shut my mouth if I were you! I have a fly life, and Dahvi has it. We're just friends! On July 14, 2010, a video was posted on 4chan (re-download shown below, left) in which Leonhardt complains of harassment. Shortly thereafter, Leonhardt was inundated with attacks on the microblogging site Tumblr. Later that night Leonhardt uploaded a video in which her father warned the attackers that they were squating proclaiming you had done goofed (shown below, right). Anonymous soon discovered her personal information, including her phone number, address and her Twitter account. People soon began flooding the Leonhardt family with prank calls (shown below, left) and hate emails. In a Stickam video uploaded on July 15 (below, right), Jesse answers phone calls during one of the pranks. Jessi's Father's Rant After an incessant wave of harassment by trolls, Jessie posted a tearful video on YouTube in which her father Jean Leonhardt suddenly enters the frame and utters an angry rant. Unwittingly, he delivered a highly exploited speech that quickly became adapted into and macro images including you made goofed, rollback, cyberpolice, and consequences will never be the same. Shortly thereafter, separate sites were launched YouDunGoofd.com such BecauseIBacktracedIt.com and Such sites. Hoax: Jesse Slaughter Given PCP Around 3:00 pm (EST) July 16, 2010, unsubstantiated rumors about Jesse Boyne Given PCP her father began to grow rapidly on YouTube and Google Trends. The malicious hoax was picked up by social bookmarking services and blogs, where it was soon revealed how mere misinformation spread to trolls using tactics like Googlebombing. On July 16 and 17, the online drama was covered by numerous online blogs and news sites, including The Daily What, BuzzFeed, BoingBoing, Gawker and the San Francisco Chronicle. YouTube Parodies on YouTube, viewers followed up with their own remixes, revamps and other comments on Jesse and her father's rant. The police investigation according to Jesse's mother, Diana Leonhardt, in addition to prank calls posted after her phone number was circulated online, the family began receiving death threats. Because of this, Gawker reported on the evening of July 13 that Jesse was placed under police guard shortly after the video went viral. A local sheriff has launched a criminal investigation into the calls and a court has ordered her to stay off the internet until at least July 21. In addition, the family is currently under constant police surveillance. Hours later, Gawker updated the article to note that a spokeswoman from the Marion County Sheriff's Department said that while there is now an investigation involving an 11-year-old girl, they are looking into the existence of pornographic photos of her and prank calls referring to them. The spokesman also said: There have been no death threats or threats of harm in any way. The latest footage uploaded on August 2, 2010 purportedly shows a heated argument between Jessie and her father, recorded by another Tinchat user, who was registered in the same chat room during her party exchange with her father. On March 25, 2011, The Daily What reported that Gene Leonhardt appeared in court to plead not guilty to child abuse charges. He was released on \$5,000 bail. According to an official report filed by the Marion County Sheriff's Deputy, Leonhardt allegedly punched Jessica in the mouth during a heated argument that resulted in her bleeding. Leonhardt, who police say was intoxicated, claims he punched his daughter after she hit him and that the blood on her face was theatrical blood. On July 7, 2011, the Marion County Sheriff's Office released additional police reports, and The Smoking Gun published an article revealing details of Jesse's behavioral problems and the arrest of Gene Leonhardt in early February. 4chan vs Gawker Included in Adrian Chen Gawker articles about the situation was one entitled The Art of Trolling: Trolling: 4chan Smear campaign. After outlining a 4chan attack plan against Dahvie's vanity with screenshots and links, Chen is connected to the chatroom, bold by readers trolling him. Furious, /b/ intended to remove the main servers of Gawker around noon on July 19. When the site did not go down, the attack on Adrian Chen was launched. Gawker published an article detailing the entire story, saying they were not afraid. Coverage of The Attempt to Remove Gawker appeared on the Village Voice blog and New York's Magazine's Daily Intel. Jesse's mother speaks on July 20. Momlogic interviewed Jesse's mother; revealing her own lack of parental supervision. Excerpt: M: Did you know what your daughter was doing and posting these videos online? DL: Jessica has a webcam and a computer. All her friends have webcams, too, so they video chat with each other. I knew she made a video to apply for America's Got Talent. She sings and sent an audition video in. I had no idea she was doing other videos. I saw her chatting with her friends but didn't make the video. M: When did you find out about the video and what was your reaction? DL: Officers said there was a video, but Jess denied she had made them. Then my mother-in-law called and said there was a video. But I didn't watch them. I can't be in a room 24 hours at 7. We tried to talk to Jess last night, but she was very upset over and over again. I'm trying to get her back to normal. It had a very emotional impact on her. I don't know if she made these videos or not, but she says she didn't. Now I'm trying to figure out what's real and what's not. It was very difficult to deal with. Jessie on Good Morning America on July 22. Jessie appeared on Good Morning America to discuss how the reaction to her video changed her life and revealed that she would begin counseling. 4chan prepared for mention from the show with operation /b/polar, and played Good Morning America theme against the background /b/ board with a sticky thread depicting this image. That day, 4chan is family-focused became a trending search on Google Insights. Apologies to Jesse on August 11, 2011. YouTuber HiroKasumi uploaded a video titled Jesse Murder Apology (2011), where Jessica apologizes to the blood band on the dance floor for the rape allegation. She claims that she is currently in foster care after going through several psychiatric institutions. A video recorded by her friend, since she has no computer privileges The death of Jesse's father on August 14, 2011. Jesse's mother posted a status update on her Facebook account, claiming that her husband Gene Leonhardt passed away on August 11, the same day her apology video was uploaded, due to a massive heart attack; a screenshot of a Facebook post was posted on Funny Junk on August 15. According to an obituary in the West Virginia Gazette, Gene K. Leonhardt died On August 11, 2011. Gene C. Leonhardt, 53, of Dannelton died August 11, 2011, at his home. on YouTube on January 23, 2012. Jesse Slaughter created a new YouTube account called ShinigamiKilla. On March 7, Leonhardt created the Tumblr blog Gorgonize The Masses in which several posts answered questions from fans. On April 8, a @DamienAkuma Twitter account was created, with several tweets containing several tweets referring to the mythical essence of Slender Man. The account contained a description suggesting that Leonhardt would change his name to Damien. On April 27, a video entitled Lovely - MorningStar A Work in Progress was uploaded to the channel, which included a song written by Leonhardt accompanied by several photos of himself (see below, left). On May 28, a thread was created on GuruGossip cosmetic forums associated with the ShinigamiKilla channel, claiming that Leonhardt had become transgender. On June 3, Leonhardt uploaded a video (shown below, right) announcing that she would answer viewers' questions, but warned not to ask questions about her deceased father. On June 5, the online culture news blog The Daily Dot published an article titled Controversial Cyberbully Victim Jessica Leonhardt returns to YouTube, noting that Leonhardt appears to be surprisingly happy in many new videos. Chris Hansen investigation March 25, 2020, Leonhardt appeared on Chris Hansen's YouTube show Have a Place with Chris Hansen and publicly accused Jesus David Torres of sexual assault when they were 10. The video has garnered more than 235,000 views. On July 2, 2020, Leonhardt was the subject of an insider article about their abuse by Torres. The article says that more than 21 women also spoke out against Torres. An insider said: Allegations of Torres sexually assaulting women and girls circulated online throughout the blood on the dance floor, from 2007 to 2016, and after, but Torres was never prosecuted. In 2019, the rumors ended with a HuffPost report detailing 21 allegations of sexual assault against Torres, who maintains active social media profiles and continues to release music under new aliases. For years, Leonhardt, now 21, quietly observed the growing number of allegations and records about Torres. As the name Jessi Slaughter fades into obscurity, Leonhardt began to identify as nonbinary, using the pronouns they both had, and going by the name of Damien. After receiving therapy and other mental health treatment, Leonhardt began telling friends and subscribers online about their experiences with Torres from a different perspective, which includes allegations of child sexual abuse.
